



Transportation Options for Day Camp 2021

Day Camp program runs Monday to Friday for two weeks (See session dates below)

HOW DO I PICK MY SESSION?

NEED BUS TRANSPORTATION ?: Please review and pick your stop carefully; once your child/children are enrolled, they will be assigned to this stop. **For the safety of your child, they are not permitted to change buses or stops at any time.** The selected mode of transportation must be the same for their Camp arrival and departure. Transportation is only provided to the bus stops listed below. These are projected stops/routes. All stops/routes are contingent on camper enrollment and may be subject to change.

DON'T NEED BUS TRANSPORTATION (Car drop off/pick up): If you are bringing your child to Camp by car each day, please review the Car pick-up and drop-off times listed on the 2nd page.

Choose up to two sessions: Registered campers attending Day Camp may also enroll for one Overnight Camp Session. Make sure session dates do not overlap.

Returning from Camp- Bus drop-off:

The buses will depart Camp (Horsham) from 4:00-4:15 pm each day. Depending on your assigned stop, children will return between 4:50 pm- 5:30 pm (depending on traffic). There will be a Day Camp counselor on each bus to take attendance and supervise the campers on the bus ride. Please be on time to meet your child at the end of each day. **The Camp's responsibility ends when your child steps off the bus.** Good behavior is expected of all campers while at Camp and while riding the bus. **Please read the Camp School Bus Conduct Rules and Camper Code of Conduct in the parent handbook with your child/children. Please Note: There will be an early dismissal from Camp at 2:00 pm on the last day of each session 07/2, 7/16, 7/30, 08/13/2021.**

Parents will be asked to perform screenings using a provided checklist before arrival every morning. If a child is experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 at home, the child should not come in that day. Each child's temperature will be taken upon arrival at College Settlement. The nurse or designated staff will also ask the following questions:

1. Have you been exposed to anyone with COVID-19 in the last 14 days?
2. Have you or your child been out of the state?
3. Have you had any signs or symptoms of COVID-19 such as fever, cough, etc?

If a child is riding the bus, he/she will get a temperature check before being able to board the bus each day. If the child's temperature is 100.4 or higher-he/she will not be able to attend camp and must have a Rapid Test with a Negative result before returning. Parents **MUST** wait until their child is on the bus before leaving the bus stop.

If a camper becomes ill with symptoms of COVID-19 while at camp, the nurse will send him/her to the quarantine area. Parents/emergency contacts will be contacted and asked to pick up their child(ren) within 2 hours of the call. Before the child can return, he/she will need a COVID-19 test. Children who test positive for COVID-19 will not be permitted to return without medical clearance or a negative COVID-19 test.

Car drop off/pick up at Day Camp

Pick your session:

- **Session 1:** Monday, June 21 – Friday, July 2, 2021
- **Session 2:** Monday, July 5 – Friday, July 16, 2021
- **Session 3:** Monday, July 19 – Friday, July 30, 2021
- **Session 4:** Monday, August 2 – Friday, August 13, 2021

Car drop off/pick up hours- Monday- Friday

Car pick-up/drop-off program hours are 7:45 am- 5:30 pm. Car parents can drop their child/children off between 7:45 am-8:45 am and pick them up between 4:15 pm – 5:30 pm.

You must be on time when dropping off or picking up your child or children. Late drop off after 8:45 am and pick up before 4:15 pm disrupts program. If you are late multiple times, it could result in your child/children being dismissed from Camp. A completed car drop-off/pick-up authorization form is required for each camper and can be filled out in your online account and will also be sent to you with your acceptance packet. Camper mode of transportation must be the same for their arrival and departure to Camp.

Please note: There will be an early dismissal from Camp at 2:00 pm on the last day of each session 07/2, 7/16, 7/30, 08/13/2021.
